

Allply Plywood





Allply is a tropical hardwood plywood panel that is produced in South America. It has a light-colored tropical hardwood, typically Amescla, veneer on the face and back. The core consists of Amescla combined with Elliotis and Caribbean Pine.

Allply has more than the standard number of plies, it always has an exterior glue line and it's available in many oversized panels.

Key Features:

- 80% of the time it is a whole piece face with the exception of a 12' panel, where there will be a scarf joint at the 8' to 10' mark.
- 18mm sheet has 9 plies, 12mm sheet has 7 plies, 2 more plies than in standard US plywood.
- Face is sanded to a 150 grit, back to a 120-150 grit
- Grade is BB on the front and CC on the back, graded by the IHPA (International Hardwood Plywood Association)
- BB Grade features:
 - No open knots
 - No color variation
 - No roughness in the veneer
 - No repair patches
 - No excessive putty
