

Yellow Birch Lumber



DISTRIBUTION Northeastern North America.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION Heartwood tends to be a light reddish brown, with nearly white sapwood. Occasionally figured pieces have a wide, shallow curl similar to curl found in Cherry. There is virtually no color distinction between annual growth rings, giving Birch a somewhat dull, uniform appearance.

WORKING PROPERTIES Generally easy to work with hand and machine tools. Turns, glues and finishes well.

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES The wood of yellow birch is relatively heavy, hard, and strong. It also has high shock resistance.

AVAILABILITY Widely available.

MAIN USES Cabinets, interior trim, paneling, flooring and interior doors.
