# Red Oak

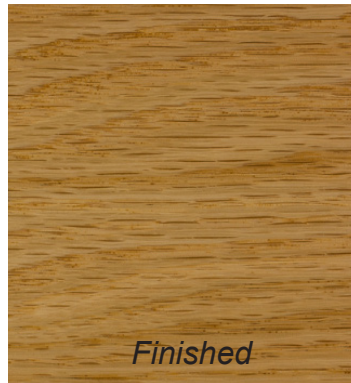
