

White Oak has a graceful tan color with a pinkish tint and and the heartwood is light-to-dark brown. It has an an elegant straight grain pattern with a medium-to-coarse texture.

ATTRIBUTES

- Moderately high shrinkage values
- Stable when dry, and doesn't darken much with age
